



HIV in the Netherlands: 2019

As of 31 December 2018, 20,104 people living with HIV were in care




20,104 HIV-positive people in care


Years since diagnosis

Age




Around 660 new HIV diagnoses in 2018


Continuum of HIV care at the end of 2018*




